SUBJECT: Beale AFB Environmental Policy Statement

1. Beale Air Force Base is committed to conducting its mission in an environmentally responsible manner that will protect human health, natural resources, and the environment. In so doing, Beale AFB will comply with all applicable Federal, state, and local requirements. Beale AFB will continually seek new opportunities for pollution prevention, waste reduction, and environmentally preferable alternatives. This commitment goes beyond compliance with the law and encompasses the integration of sound environmental practices into the daily decisions and activities of all base personnel.
2. Beale AFB will maintain an Environmental Management System (EMS) and conduct regular inspections to rate the environmental performance of its programs and activities. Beale AFB personnel will correct and improve environmental performance to the maximum extent practicable.
3. Beale AFB environmental programs will be ranked annually during Beale AFB Environmental Cross Functional Team (E-CFT) meetings chaired by the 9 MSG/CD. Environmental Action Plans (EAPs) that establish specific objectives and targets for improvement will be developed for the highest ranking programs, and will be approved by the Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Council (ESOHC). Progress toward achieving targets and objectives will be tracked by the E-CFT and reported annually to the ESOHC.
4. Every airman, organization, tenant unit, and contractor working for, or on behalf of Beale AFB is accountable for their environmental performance and will conform to this policy statement.
