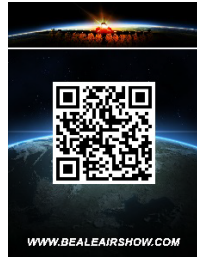

- Volunteers will be assisting with memorial tear down and clean up

GRILLING SAFETY

DID YOU KNOW?

Despite its popularity, grilling comes with risks. The number of people injured while grilling has climbed 18% in 10 years, reflecting a concerning trend alongside the growing number of people grilling/smoking at home.

DO

- ❖ Open grill (gas) before lighting
- ❖ Establish 3ft safety zone around grill/smoker
- ❖ Keep children/pets away
- ❖ Clean grill after each use
- ❖ Have water or a hose near by

DO NOT

- ❖ Leave grill unattended
- ❖ Overload the grill
- ❖ Grill/Smoke indoors
- ❖ Turn on the gas while grill lid is closed
- ❖ Cross contaminate foods
