STOP HUMAN TRAFFICKING – Force, fraud, or coercion to compel a person to provide labor services or commercial sex. Victims from all backgrounds. Any minor involved is a victim.

RECOGNIZE SIGNS

- Physical/Environmental indicators - Signs of abuse, no I.D., confined to worksite.
- Psychological/Behavioral Indicators – Submissive, anxious, lack of free will

TRICARE Open Season is on the Horizon

TRICARE Open Season is when you can enroll in or change your health care coverage for the next year. Enrollment changes made during Open Season will go into effect on Jan. 1, 2024.

Open season applies to anyone enrolled in or eligible for a TRICARE Prime option, including the US Family Health Plan (USFHP), or TRICARE Select. Mark Your Calendars

TRICARE Open Season is Nov. 13 through Dec. 12, 2023.

FEDVIP Open Season is Nov. 13 through Dec. 11, 2023.
