Primary Series

Pediatric Moderna: 6 months to 5 years old

2 dose series: 4-8 weeks apart

Moderna: 18 years and older

2 dose series: 4-8 weeks apart

Novavax: 18 years and up

Service members only

Wednesdays 0800-1100

• 2 dose series: 3-8 weeks apart

Pediatric Pfizer: 5 years and older

• 2 dose series: 3-8 weeks apart

Comirnaty (Pfizer): 12 years and older

• 2 dose series: 3-8 weeks apart

Boosters

Ages 5-11

Pediatric Pfizer ONLY

- 1 booster dose only
- 5 months after the completion of the primary series

Ages 12 years and above

Pfizer Tris-10 Bivalent Booster Vaccine ONLY

- 1 dose
- 2 months after the completion of a monovalent mRNA COVID-19 Vaccine
- Monovalent vaccines are no longer authorized as a booster dose

Network pharmacies:

All beneficiaries (including AD) may utilize any pharmacy that administers COVID-19 vaccines at no cost. Ensure that the vaccine name, lot number and the date of when you received your vaccines are on your CDC COVID-19 vaccination card. Records may automatically update in ASIMS.

Save your receipt and CDC Vaccination card as proof.
