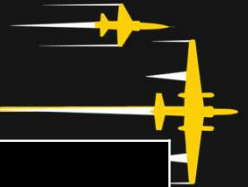

<b>Indoor mask-wearing is NOT REQUIRED.</b>	<b>Supervisors will maintain at least six feet of separation between individuals in DoD workplaces whenever possible, indoors, outdoors, and regardless of the CDC COVID-19 Community Levels.</b>	<b>&lt; 80% of normal occupancy (maximize telework to the greatest extent)</b>	<b>Required for service members, DoD civilian employees, and DoD contracted personnel. Non Fully Vaccinated require weekly screening.</b>	<b>Current Participant Limitations: None</b>	<b>Leave: Local: per AFI 36-3003  Outside Local: Unit Commander</b>
<b>Exception: Mask wear REQUIRED for Clinic services.</b>		<b>Exception: Reference (b)</b>		<b>Room Capacity Limit: 100%</b>	
		<b>Provide vaccination status. Non-vaccinated require negative test NET 72 hours.</b>
