




Recce Town HPCON Updates





Health Protection Condition



Leave Authorized.

Members are prohibited from entering the city limits of Sacramento, Reno, and San Francisco. Leave is authorized under Unit Commander approval and daily log of close contacts required



Crowd Limitations in Effect.

Maximum indoor crowds of 10 or less. Maximum outdoor crowds of 25 or less. Masks and distancing required in both settings.



Max telework, teaming and virtual platforms.

Units will follow enduring plans. Out-of-office notifications required when in telework status, and must communicate points of contact and directions for continued services.



Non-DoD ID Cardholders Restricted Individuals with approved IDs for base access will continue to transit the base. Exceptions and waivers for all others are approved at the unit commander level on a case-by-case basis.


I Feel Sick, what Should I do?

- **Do not go to work if you feel sick.** Contact your chain of command or the 9 MDG's Appointment Line for a telephone screening and assessment.
- <u>Abide by all quarantine, restrictions of movement, or isolation instructions.</u> These guidelines are readily available via Group or Squadron leadership teams and 9 MDG Public Health.
- Maintain physical distance. Maintain a minimum of six feet of separation.
- Wear a mask when required. All individuals will wear cloth face coverings when they cannot maintain 6 feet of physical distance or as posted both on and off base.
