Col. Erick O. Welcome is the Director of Communications and Cyberspace Operations, 9th Reconnaissance Wing, Beale Air Force Base, California. The A6 Directorate provides strategic vision, policy, guidance and advocacy to advance communications and cyberspace technology in support of 7,000 total force personnel, 28 units, and nine tenants across five operating locations.

The colonel enlisted in the Air Force in 1990, then received his commission through Officer Training School in 2000. He led the J6 team responsible for USSTRATCOM's effort to build the first-ever Cruise Missile Support Activity, Atlantic, Tomahawk Land Attack Missile Network Operations Center. Additionally, he served in a variety of joint, combatant command, and major command-level positions including assignments in cyber, logistics, senior leader matters, and instructor duty spanning from Operation DESERT STORM to Operation ENDURING FREEDOM.

Prior to his current assignment, he was the Deputy Chief of Staff, United States Cyber Command.
