LIEUTENANT COLONEL ANDREW M. BAUER

Lt. Col. Andrew M. Bauer is the A-Staff A9 director, 9th Reconnaissance Wing, Beale AFB, California. The A9 directorate provides wing leaders measurement of items of value and ground truth within the four major graded areas of the commander's responsibilities, focused on key performance indicators, and driving informed decision selection. Bauer leads the A9 directorate's audits of current processes and ensures the wing takes a proactive view of its performance for mitigating risks early, planning for future surges, and informing data driven decision applications. His A9 staff studies, analyzes, assesses, and develops lessons learned providing wing leaders with an integrated analysis and assessment of the overall organization.

Additionally, Bauer supports the Common Mission Control Center (CMCC), 427th Reconnaissance Squadron, building tactics, techniques and procedures to promote interoperability across manned and unmanned multidomain assets from a single command and control node in contested, degraded, operationally-limited environments. He directly supervises threat analysis, manages system and hardware for enhanced survivability in support of a classified \$40B deputy secretary of defense-directed program. Prior to his current position, he was the 9th RW's deputy chief of staff and wing inspector general.



The lieutenant colonel entered active duty in August 1995 as an aerospace ground equipment technician. He is a graduate twice of Embry Riddle Aeronautical University, Daytona Beach, Florida, and commissioned through the Air Force ROTC program in 2004. Bauer has extensive operational experience as a conventional and nuclear qualified aviator and electronic warfare subject matter expert. He has deployed four times supporting U.S. Indo-Pacific Command strategic objectives and U.S. Central Command supporting Operations INHERENT RESOLVE, FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, and the Resolute Support mission.
